### RESEARCH

1. What do you know for sure about this person?
2. From what you know, what do you suspect about this person?
3. What extra details can you imagine about this person?
  - Who? What? Where? When? How? Why?
  - Network (family, friends, colleagues?)
  - Location(s) (How often/happy are they there?)
  - Interests? Hobbies? Dreams? Expectations?

### INTERVIEW

1. Develop interview questions to ask this person so they can tell you in detail what they were looking for, what they found and what they did: “When did you first...?” “What made you...?” “How did you...”. Finish by asking them how they feel about the experience now and what their plans are.
2. Roleplay the interview with a partner.
